BRAIN INJURY FACTS:

- Brain injury is the most likely to result in permanent disability and death
- Brain injury is the greatest killer under the age of 45, the greatest disabler under the age of 44 and kills more children under the age of 20 than all other causes combined.
- Approximately 1.5 million people in Canada are living with brain injury.
- Survival rates have increased with advanced trauma services and improved treatment options. And that's a good thing.

Survivors come to the support group meeting not only to support each other but also to share food together. Last winter, we decided to have a potluck once a month to fill our stomach with delicious food brought by members.








Fundraising Activities

JORDAN RILEY CHARITY BIKE RIDE FOR MBIA



Meet Jordan Riley. On November 29, 2015. Jordan suffered a traumatic brain injury, resulting from a fall from his roof. Jordan was transported to Winnipeg, Manitoba. Where he was diagnosed with a subdural hematoma and a fractured skull. Jordan immediately underwent extensive surgery to stop the bleeding in his brain. The odds of a full recovery did not look well. Jordan remained in hospital for a month, and from there went on to complete 4 weeks of extensive rehabilitation. Since then he has defeated the odds, and

returned back to a normal life.

Today, Jordan has decided to use his experience to bring awareness to people suffering with brain injuries. On September 10, 2016. Jordan will ride from Lac du Bonnet, Manitoba to Winnipeg, Manitoba and back. A distance of 214km. All in support of Manitoba Brain Injury Association.
